### Ending Sounds: -ed and -s - answers

1. Wanted, ended and started are pronounced /**ɪd**/  
Finished is different. -ed is pronounced /**t**/
2. Hoped, stopped and liked are pronounced /**t**/  
Hated is different. -ed is pronounced /**ɪd**/
3. Moved, lived and climbed are pronounced /**d**/  
Needed is different. -ed is pronounced /**ɪd**/
4. Likes, stops and drinks are pronounced /**s**/  
Misses is different. -s is pronounced /**ɪz**/
5. Watches, catches and finishes are pronounced /**ɪz**/  
Hates is different. -s is pronounced /**s**/
6. Ends, learns and drives are pronounced /**z**/  
Starts is different. -s is pronounced /**s**/
