

How to make 'My English telephone'

- Write the numbers for the telephone keys 0-9 on the stickers or small pieces of paper.
 - Stick the numbers in lines of 3 on the side of a cup.
 - Make a small hole in the base of the cup using a pen or scissors blade. (Teacher can do this for students if appropriate)
 - Thread a 2metre length of string through the hole and tie a double knot at the end *inside* the cup.
 - Repeat the previous steps with a second cup.
 - Thread the free end of the string through the hole and tie a knot on the *inside* of the other cup.
 - Students A and B stand apart, until the string is taut. A puts the open end of the cup phone to her ear and B talks into his cup phone. Take turns to listen and speak.
