I took this photo a couple of years ago in the square in front of the cathedral, which is very near my house, about a minute **(1)**.... the hill. You've also got the contrast between the bones, you can see some bones there on the right, bread, the basket, and they're **(11)**.... contrast with the plastic plate, the plastic cup, the soft drinks cans, again it's the historical and the more modern.

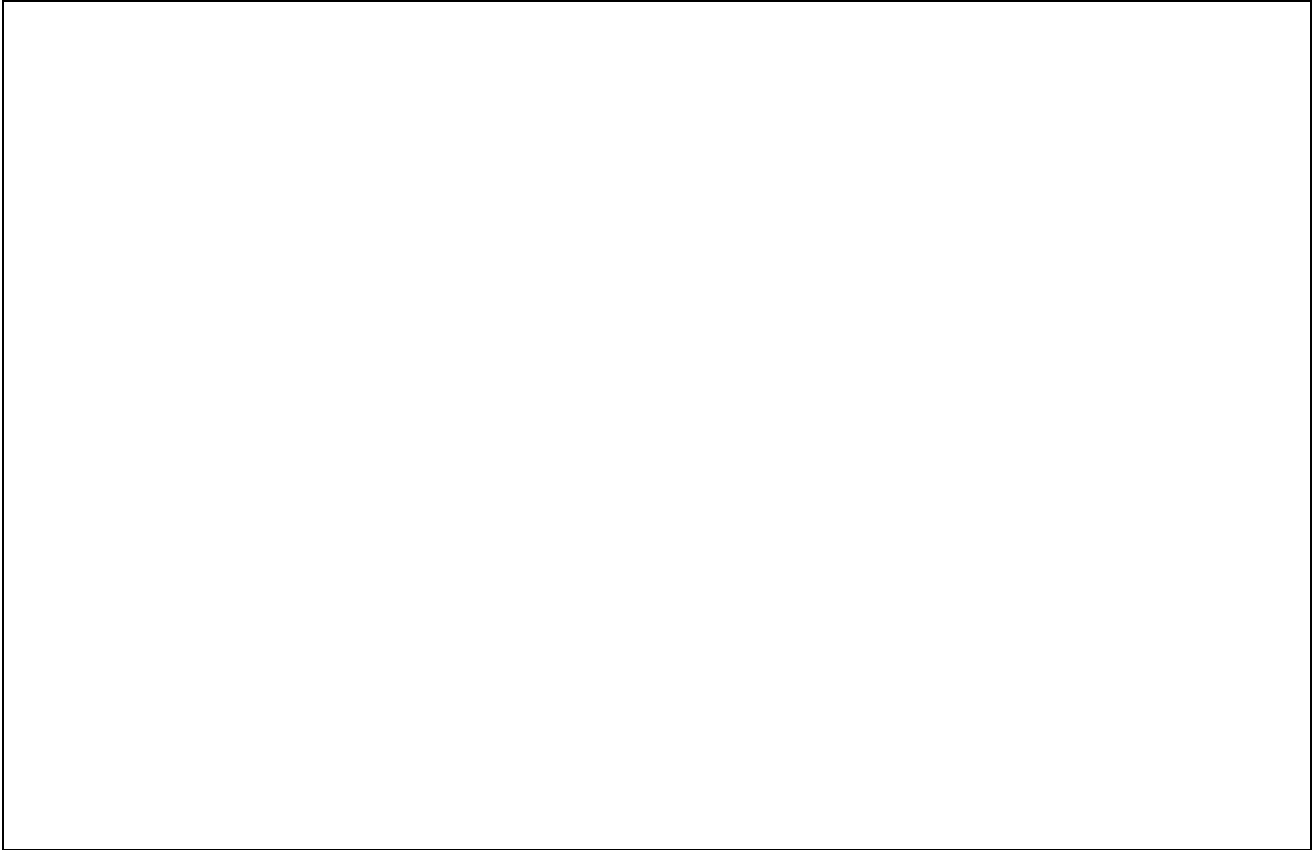
