



# Using the Pathway Builder

The British Council has created a self-directed learning pathway to help teacher educators develop their skills and understanding. Follow these steps to complete the Pathway Builder and download your certificate of completion.

Download and familiarise yourself with the British Council's **Continuing Professional Development (CPD) Framework for teacher educators.**

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Take the Teacher Educator Self-Assessment Tool (TESAT). You can use the **Profile Chart** to record your strengths and the professional practices you'd like to develop further. Here is an example.
