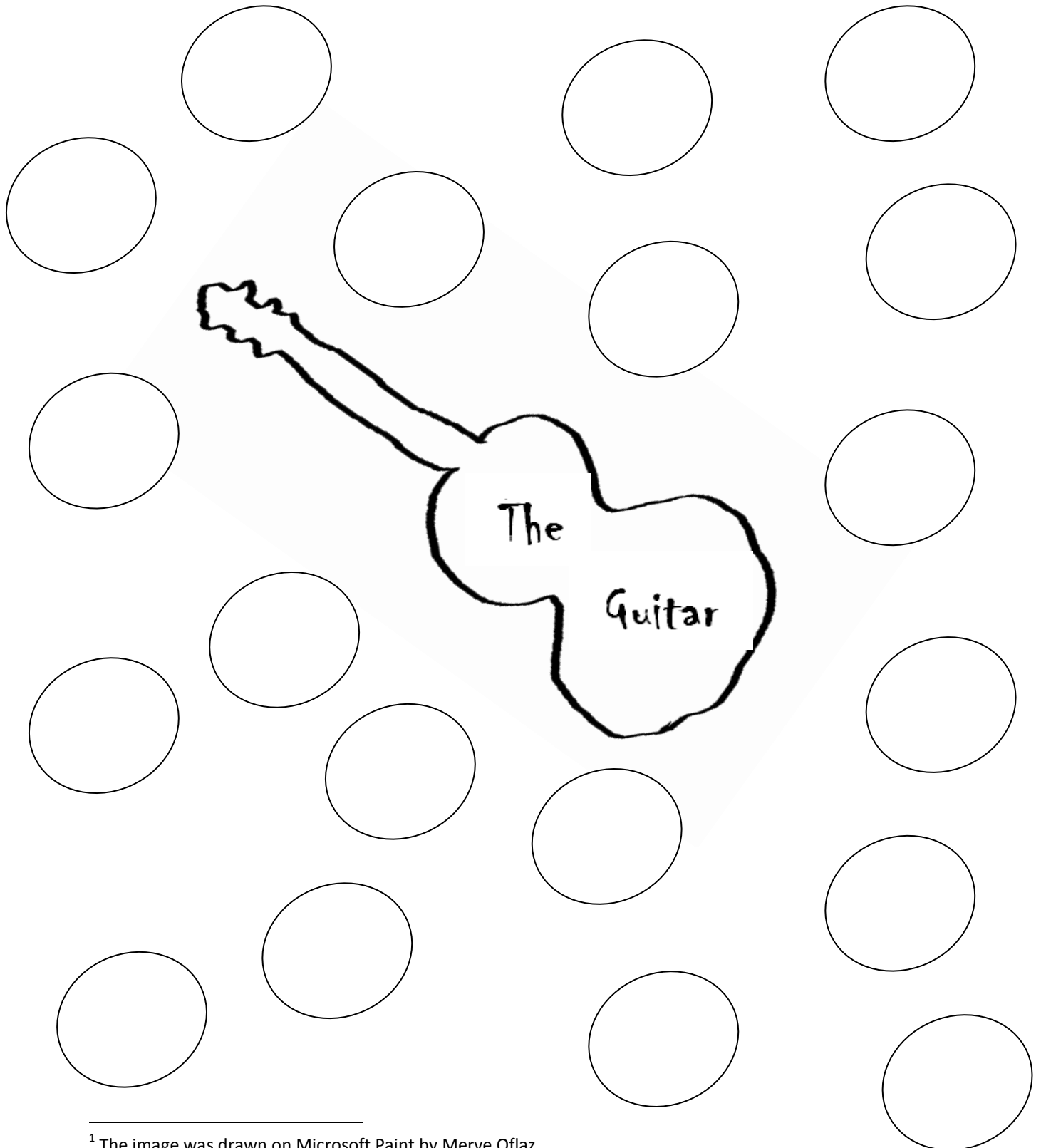

 Can you play a musical instrument? If yes, what is it?	 Sing the song ' <i>Arkadaşım Eşek</i> '. If you can't, tweet like a bird.
 What is your biggest dream?	 Sing the song ' <i>Gülperembe</i> '. If you can't, walk like a penguin.
 Do you learn by 'trial and error' or by following the instructions or rules? Give an example.	 Sing the song ' <i>Domates, Biber, Patlıcan</i> '. If you can't, jump like a kangaroo.
 If you bought a guitar, would it be classical or electric? Why?	 Have you ever watched a street band perform? If yes, what was it like?
 If you bought a guitar, what colour would you prefer? Why?	 Do you know any musicians who can play the guitar? If yes, name them.
 Have you ever given up something you liked doing very much? What and why?	 If you had the chance, what instrument would you learn to play?
 Imitate someone playing the drums.	 If you learned how to play the guitar, what would you play as your first song? Why?
 Imitate someone playing the clarinet.	 When you ask your parents to buy something, do you ever think about whether they can afford it or not?
 Imitate someone playing the violin.	 If you needed to practice a musical instrument, in which room of the house would you do it? Why?
