

## KIM'S GAME



Language: cat, cow, dog, donkey, duck, frog, goat, pig, pony, sheep

Materials: flashcards of the animals

- 1. Blu-tac the animal cards on the board one by one and elicit their name from the children. Ask the children "How many animals are there?"
- 2. Take the cards down, one by one, eliciting the name of the animal as you do so.
- 3. Stand in front of the class with the cards. Let them see that you are mixing up the cards.
- 4. Blu-tac each card back on the board, except one. Ask the children to guess which animal is missing.
- 5. Repeat the procedure, leaving out 2 or 3 animals for children to guess.
- 6. You can also do this with students holding the cards in front of the class.
