

Complete the sentence (worksheet A)

A seed needs soil, sun, rain and air to grow.

Complete the sentences (worksheet B)

A seed needs <u>soil</u>, <u>sun</u>, <u>rain</u> and <u>air</u> to grow. A seed grows <u>roots</u> under the ground and a <u>stem</u> with <u>leaves</u> on it above the ground. The <u>flower</u> starts as a small <u>bud</u>. A <u>new seed</u> grows inside the flower.
